1.3.1 Report of Value Education Programme

The college has adopted the value education programmes offered by Chair for Christian Studies and Research, University of Calicut from the academic year 2017-2018 onwards, for the entire UG students of our college. As per the programme the students cover a well framed syllabus offered by the university. A panel of teachers are specially arranged to handle the ethics classes. Every Wednesday the third hour was exclusively meant for value education classes. The entire UG students are grouped into different batches and each batch is handled by a teacher in charge of the class and at the end of the academic year exams are conducted as per the university notification from Chair for Christian Studies and Research, University of Calicut. Apart from this special value education classes are also arranged which are handled by external experts. Till now two batches of UG students (2017-20 and 2018-21 admission) could successfully complete the programme.

2017-2018

During the academic year 2017-2018 a number of 715 first year students were registered for the value education program. The inaugural function of the programme was done by Mr. Roy C G, SI of Police, Thrissur on 28th July 2017 and he delivered a class on the topics cyber world and ethical issues. The college conducted the value education examination for the UG students on 9th February 2018. On 7th February a summary class was arranged for the first year students which was handled by Sr. Jisna Jose (Librarian, Vimala College).

Our students and the orator had a healthy interactive session, involving real life cases of child abuse and the consequent explanations of action to be taken in such instances. The session was really informative, equipping all the listeners, the necessity of taking steps towards the crimes against children.
