2.1.1 Average Enrolment Percentage – Orders on Marginal Increase (2016-2021)

Abstract of the Order no. 11396/CDC-A3/2017/Admn (I) dated 24-09-2020 regarding marginal increase issued by University of Calicut

In the wake of COVID 19, universities are permitted to increase the sanctioned seats in affiliated colleges, to a maximum of 70 for UG programmes, 25 for PG programmes and 30 for Arts and Commerce based on each college's existing facilities.

However, this marginal increase is valid only for the academic year 2020-21 and for programmes which commenced in 2018-19 or before. This marginal increase should neither cause change in the sanctioned intake number nor incur any financial burden on the university/government.

ORDER

As per U.O. read as 1st paper above, it has been ordered to grant 20% of marginal increase of seats on the sanctioned strength, within the statutory limit for admission to UG/PG programmes (in Arts and Science and Oriental title colleges) 2019-20 academic year for the programmes under Govt and aided stream. Further, upon request, marginal Increase of seats is granted, for the academic year 2019-20, upto the Statutory maximum Limit to all the programmes under Govt. and Aided stream (in Arts and Science and Oriental title colleges) and also to the programmes in the colleges under the sponsorship of Co-operatives / LBS / IHRD, based on the application and the recommendation of the inspection commission. It has also been ordered to grant marginal increase of seats for the academic year 2019-20 to self-financing programmes (in Arts and Science and Oriental title colleges) upto 20% of the sanctioned strength, subject to the Statutory Maximum Limit based on the application submitted in the prescribed format within the prescribed time and also based on the recommendation of the inspection commission. Accordingly applications have been received from the various affiliated colleges for granting marginal increase of seats to self-financing programmes for the academic year 2019-20.

- 2. A Syndicate sub committee has been constituted vide reference 2 nd above, with members Sri.K.K.Haneefa (Convenor), Dr. P. Vijayaraghavan, Sri. K.K. Balakrishnan, Prof. Bahuleyan, Dr.Shamsad Hussain and Sri. Eugin Moreli in connection with the sanctioning of new colleges, programmes and additional intake. The committee meeting held on 29/04/2019 considered the matter of granting marginal increase to the self financing programmes and recommended the following.
- a) To grant marginal increase of seats to self-financing programmes (in Arts and Science and Oriental title colleges) for the academic year 2019-20 as detailed below, subject to the submission of application within the prescribed time.
 - i) upto 20% of the sanctioned strength, subject to the Statutory Maximum of the programmes.
- ii) upto the statutory maximum of the programmes which are conducted by IHRD/ LBS/ Cooperative agencies.
- b). To grant marginal increase of seats as mentioned above, to self-financing programmes for which the applications have been submitted for permanent increase. The marginal increase of seats sanctioned will be adjusted in due course, while granting permanent increase.
- 3. The above recommemndations of the Syndicate sub-committee was placed before the Syndicate for consideration and the Syndicate meeting held on 18/05/2019 vide paper read as 3rd above, has resolved to approve the recommendations of the Syndicate Sub-committee meeting in connection with the granting of

marginal increase of intake for the year 2019-20 to self financing programmes under Arts and Science and Oriental title colleges.

- 4. Considering the matter in detail, Vice Chancellor on 23/05/2019, accorded sanction to implement Syndicate Resolution No. 2019-417* dated 18/05/2019.
- 5. The marginal increase of intake for the year 2019-20 is, therefore, sanctioned to the various programmes under self financing stream as per the list attached herewith.
 - 6. The marginal increase so sanctioned shall be subject to the following general conditions.
 - a. The marginal increase sanctioned is purely provisional and specifically for the academic year 2019-20 and should not be taken as an addition to the sanctioned strength.
 - b. The seat ratio share between different quota (general, management, community etc) will be the same as that was followed in the case of the actual sanctioned strength of the programme.
 - c. The marginal increase is sanctioned subject to the condition that it should not involve any additional staff and or additional financial commitment either to the Government or to the University.
 - d. The admission to the marginally increased seats should be made strictly as per the admission rules issued by the University and subject to the the continuation of provisional affiliation for the academic year.
- 7. All affiliated college should strictly adhere to the above directions while admitting students in their college in order to avoid any further proceedings from the University.

It has also been ordered to grant marginal increase to all UG and PG programmes (Including Afzal -ul - Ulama and Abid-E-Fazil programmes) in self financing stream, up to 20 % of the sanctioned strength, for the academic year 2018-19, based on the application submitted by the Principals along with required fee and also based on the report of the DLIC concerned. ORDER

As per paper read as first above, the following decisions were taken for granting marginal increase of seats to UG and PG programmes for the academic year 2016-17, well in advance to enable Directorate of Admission to finalise the seat distribution before the commencement of online registration for admissions.

- As the admission is through Single Window, Marginal increase is allowed to all programmes in all colleges without waiting for an application from the College and with the condition that it should not involve any financial commitment to Govt. or University.
- Marginal Increase shall be allowed upto 25% of the sanctioned strength in Arts, Afzal-ul-Ulama and B.P.Ed programmes subject to the maximum of the statutory limit.
- Marginal Increase shall be allowed upto 40% of the sanctioned strength in Commerce programmes subject to the maximum of the statutory limit.
- In case of Science subjects, marginal increase of seats is allowed upto the statutory maximum
 of each programme considering the decrease in the number of students due to admission to
 professional programmes.
- The Statutory Limit for UG Programmes is as follows.

Languages	40 seats each
Arts and Commerce	60 seats each
Science Subjects, i.e. Mathematics,	48 seats each
Physics, Chemistry	46 SealS each
Other Science Subjects	36 seats each

The Statutory limit for PG programmes is as follows

Arts, Languages and Mathematics	20 seats
Science Subjects	12 seats

• The seat ratio share between different quota (general, management, community etc.) will be the same as that was followed in the case of the actual sanctioned strength of the programme.

As per Calicut University First Statute, 1977, Chapter 23, Statute 31

- (d) No increase in strength or additional courses shall be permitted until the first batch has been presented for the University examination. When the courses become stabilized, the student strength for main subjects may be increased to:
 - Languages 40
 - Arts subjects 60
 - Science subjects, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry 48 each
 - Other Science subjects 36 each.
- (e) Not more than four post-graduate courses will be normally allowed in a college. The maximum students strength for post-graduate courses will be
 - Arts and Languages (including Mathematics) 15 to 20
 - Science subjects 12

After considering the matter in detail, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction after exercising the powers vested upon him as per section 10 (13) of Chapter - III of the Calicut University Act, 1975, to grant marginal increase of seats to UG and PG programmes for the academic year 2016-17 as detailed below, subject to the ratification of the Syndicate.

- 1. No college shall admit students in excess of statutory maximum intake in any case including sanctioned strength, permanent increase and additional seats sanctioned, if any.
- 2. Marginal Increase shall be allowed upto 25% of the sanctioned strength in Arts, Afzal-ul-Ulama and B.P.Ed programmes subject to the maximum of the statutory limit.
- 3. Marginal Increase shall be allowed upto 40% of the sanctioned strength in Commerce programmes subject to the maximum of the statutory limit.
- 4. In the case of Science subjects, colleges shall be allowed to admit upto the statutory maximum strength of each programme, taking into consideration the number of students who have requested for transfer to professional courses in previous years.
- 5. The last date of admission as per the schedule issued shall not be changed for regularizing the working days required for the semester programme.
- 6. The increase is sanctioned subject to the condition that it should not involve any additional staff and additional financial commitment either to the Government or to the University.
- 7. The admission to the marginally increased seats should be made strictly as per the admission rules issued by the University and subject to continuation of provisional affiliation of the academic year.
- 8. In case of colleges for which permanent increase of seats are sanctioned in the current

academic year, no marginal increase is allowed.

9. In case of double main courses (programmes) marginal increase of seats is sanctioned upto the

statutory limit in the subject which is having the higher limit.

10. The Statutory Limit for UG Programmes is as follows:

Languages – 40 seats each

Arts and Commerce - 60 seats each

Science Subjects, i.e. Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry - 48 seats each

Other Science Subjects - 36 seats each

11. The Statutory limit for PG programmes is as follows:

Arts & Languages (including Mathematics) - 20 seats

Science Subjects - 12 seats

The marginal increase sanctioned is purely provisional and specifically for the academic year

2016-17 and should not be taken as an addition to the sanctioned strength. The total strength

shall not exceed the Statutory maximum limit including sanctioned strength, marginal increase,

permanent increase and additional seats sanctioned, if any, and the Principals shall ensure that.

The increase is sanctioned subject to the condition that it should not involve any additional staff

and additional financial commitment either to the Government or to the University. It is further

ordered that the admission to the marginally increased seats should be made strictly as per the

admission rules issued by the University, i.e. the seat ratio share between different quota

(general, management, community etc.) will be the same as that was followed in the case of the actual

sanctioned strength of the programme.

Orders are issued accordingly.
