The webinar was started with welcome speech by Anjali Muraleedharan, the student coordinator from department of psychology. The resource person, Ms Ashwathy Prasad clinical psychologist trainee, Amritha Institute of Medical sciences, Kochi, gave informative speech about the prospects of psychology. Then explained about the difference between psychologist and clinical psychologist and made clear that there are certain rights and privileges for clinical psychologist in Indian scenario than a psychologist. Then she made a comment that specialised masters in psychology gives us good foundation for career. After that she explained about


Assessment Períod (2016 - 2021)





At the end of the webinar there was an interactive section between the resource person and students. As the end was approaching there was a self satisfaction for students after gaining knowledge about prospects of Psychology.


