INAUGURATION OF SCIENCE & RELIGION CLUB 15th February 2018, Vimala College, Thrissur

The inauguration of the Science Religion Club of Vimala College, Thrissur, Kerala was held on 15th February 2018. Rev. Dr. Augustine Pamplany, the Director of the Institute of Science and Religion, Aluva, Kerala was the chief guest. The Club strives to create a community for safe, intellectual conversations about faith and science. The Science and Religion Club also aspire to strengthen the faith of scholars while broadening their minds about the harmony between science and faith. This will help to motivate the youth to include values and scientific temperament for the good of humanity.

The initiation of the club was made possible through funding from the Oxford Interdisciplinary Seminars in Science and Religion: Bridging the Two Cultures of Science and the Humanities, organized by Scholarship and Christianity in Oxford (SCIO), United Kingdom with funding from Templeton Religion Trust and Blank Mayer Foundation.









Dr. Augustine Pamplany briefly discussed about the neuroscience and neuro religion and the complexity of brain and he said that atheism is a biological disorder. He emphasized that Science offers a surer path to God than religion. He quoted the example of Anthony Flew, the atheist from Cambridge University, United Kingdom. Materialism is the foundation of faith today and he commended about the universal brotherhood and we have 99% genetic overlap with Chimpanzee, 80% with cows and 60 % with mouse. There is a biological continuity and therefore the age old conflict between science and religion is the affair of the past. They are not contradictory rather complementary and a creative and harmonious blending of the scientific ideas and religious values are not just an option but an obligation, if the humanity want to progress along the right path.

He congratulated and appreciated the organizers for initiating Science and Religion Club in the College. In fact, Vimala College is the first women's college in the State, started the Science and Region club which added another feather to the rich historical legacy of the institution.

The Science & Religion Club of Vimala College, Thrissur, Kerala in collaboration with Scholarship and Christianity in Oxford (SCIO), United Kingdom organizes 'Pro Scientia Et Religione', series of programme comprises of lecture series, conferences/ colloquiums/ workshops, panel discussions, paper presentations and so on. As a part of this programme Science and Religion Club of Vimala College organizes paper presentation competition on 22nd February 2018.



Track of themes for the presentation were Religion and culture, Crispr cas9 gene editing technique and ethical issues, Human Genome Project and ethics, Genetically Modified organisms Pros and Cons, Cloning and ethical aspects, Origin of life controversies, The discovery of gravitational waves and the future of religion & society, Big Bang Theory and origin of the Universe, Developments in Neurological sciences, Recent advances in Genetic Sciences and its impact on religion and culture, Evolution controversy and science playing God, Artificial intelligence and future of human beings, Fuzzy language for god and religion, Ethics of synthesizing life in the lab and Spiritual intelligence for intellectual empowerment. The competition was meant for Undergraduate/Postgraduate students, Faculty and Research scholars. Staff and students from various Colleges actively participated in the competition.

Ethics of synthesizing life in the lab, Science and religion is not contradictory but complementary, a journey from self-annihilation to self-affirmation: Terra Incognita and cosmogenesis, Equipping and empowering youth for evangelism, Crispr/ Cas9 mediated gene editing: prospects and ethical concerns were some of the topics presented in the competition.

Faculty Advisor for Science & Religion Club, Dr. Sr. Beena Jose expressed gratitude and acknowledged the financial support from SCIO, Oxford, UK. The scientific power becomes more and more effective and benevolent only when it is guided by religion and morality. There is need for harmony between Science and Religion. Therefore it is now quite evident that science and religion should work together for the well-being of the humanity. The scientist with his belief in God and the principles of morality can achieve many things for the betterment of humanity. College Principal Dr. Sr. Marriette A. Therattil distributed the certificates and prizes to the winners.




