
3. Poovili 2020 –intercollegiate quiz competition on Onam flowers – Enflammer-The journal club


Brief Report of the Event:








Most of the participants uploaded self-taken photographs of local exotic species along with its short description of that plant and its eradication method. 18 participants had uploaded their documents. Among them, 1st prize was earned by Anu C Benny from St. Thomas College (Autonomous), Thrissur with Rs.250/- cash prize and 2nd prize was shared by Shwetha Somasundaran from Sacred Heart College, Thevara and Sneha Shaji from Vimala College (Autonomous), Thrissur with Rs.100/-cash prize. Giant Sensitive Plant







Mimosa diplotricha C. Wright (Giant Sensitive Plant/ Aanathottavadi) is a fast growing woody shrub included in the family Fabaceae, native to tropical America. It is cited as one among 100 of the world's worst invaders in the Global Invasive Species Database. This plant can grow to atleast 5 meters high and the four angled stem is covered with prickly, hooked spines that faces in opposite direction. Leaves are small green pinnate leaves having many leaflets and the flowers are found in round pink inflorescence. The weed grows best in habitat such as roadsides, railway tracks, disturbed forests, plantations etc. Its massive spreading prevents the growth of other plants.

Efforts to control

It is difficult to remove manually because of its thorns and readily grows back from plant remnants and the seed bank it leaves in the soil. Eradication of *Mimosa diplotricha* is very much difficult and it is a great threat to forest ecosystems, agricultural lands and pastures. Tillage, mowing, use of certain herbicides and burning of the plant can be used as the eradication methods. Also, the all parts of the plant are toxic to herbivores if they ingested as it produces various toxins that can cause vascular endothelial damage, necrosis of heart and liver etc. in their predators.

Mexican petunia



Ruellia simplex is native to Mexico (hence known as Mexican petunia), the West Indies, western Bolivia, southwestern Brazil, Paraguay, Uruguay, and northeastern Argentina. It has been widely used as an ornamental plant and has escaped from cultivation in the United States, Australia and parts of Asia, as well as several Pacific Islands. It has become invasive in some of these areas, forming dense; single-species stands of vegetation which threatens native plants. It is mainly a plant of wet places such as ditches, pond verges, lakesides and marshes, but can survive in drier conditions.





Efforts to control

Large areas of Mexican petunia can be killed with herbicide. Many ready-mixed herbicides have been successfully used to control Mexican petunia. One of the most commonly used and easily available from local stores is glyphosate, which is sold under the trade name Roundup.

Siam weed



Chromolaena odorata is commonly known as "communist pacha" in Kerala. It is native to America, which took over the lands of Kerala. It is a multi-stemmed shrub of 2.5m tall and has soft stem later become somewhat harder when mature. The plant is hairy and glandular and has a pungent aromatic odour when crushed Research point out that its lush growth is a major environmental issue.

Efforts to control

C. odarata can be eradicated by physical, chemical and biological methods. Physical: Manual slashing and using of bush cutter. Chemical: Control using herbicides applied at seedling stage, spraying 2,4 D Amine plus picloram, kills top growth. Biological: biological control agent can be achieved by the introduction of *Pareuchaetes Pseudoinsulata*.






