The meeting commenced with a welcome note by the Chairperson.

Dr. Sr. Lissy John Irumpan followed by a briefing about the college by the Chairperson. Thereafter, the agenda was taken up for discussion.

## Item No. 1 Conduct of Examinations.

Dr. Sr. Ritty J Nedumpara, Controller of Examinations of the college, presented the rules and regulations formulated by the college for the conduct of examinations and also the preparations made towards it. She also presented



the calendar for the academic year 2016-17 that includes examination calendar for the year. The Governing Body unanimously approved the calendar. The USC nominee Prof Kuldip Singh Dhindsa provided information regarding Footproof Software for the effective conduct of examination and he also provided the names of experienced experts to be contacted for guidance, if required.

The Council also discussed the preparations made for Question Paper setting, Dr. Sr. Ritty, briefed the Council about the Question bank which is under preparation. Prof Kuldip Singh explained the importance of making examinations more problem oriented so that students can perform well in competitive examinations like the USC-NET/SET.

Item No. 2: Upgradation of syllabus.

Dr Sr. Marie V.L. Principal, reported that the syllabi of all the programmes in the college have been revised, upgraded and approved by the Academic Council. She also reported that the revised syllabi of most of the programmes have been already approved by the University and the rest is duly expected. The USC Nominee, Prof Kuldip Singh Dhindsa



intimated that the USC has already directed universities to arrange separate Section for autonomous colleges to facilitate administrative tasks.  
Item NO: 3

Starting up of New Courses.

The Governing Council discussed the new academic programmes to be launched. The Council ratified the decision to introduce two new UG programmes - BCom (Co-operation) and BSc Psychology. These programmes are scheduled to begin during the academic year 2016-17. These courses have been already approved by the University and awaiting approval from the State Government. The Council also discussed about the programmes to be introduced in the next academic year. Following elaborate deliberation, the Governing Body resolved to consider introducing the following programmes for 2017-18. 1. BA Women's Studies, 2. B.LSc 3. PG Diploma in Nutrition and Dietetics 4. PG Diploma in Multimedia 5. BCom Finance, 6. MSc Computer Science 7. MA/BA English with Media Studies

Prof. Kuldip Singh emphasized the importance of faculty taking up PDF and fellowships in reputed institutes within India such as



the Indian Institute of Science, Tata Institute of Fundamental Research and IITs and also institutes outside. He also emphasized on the importance of availing UGC grants by teachers to present papers at international conferences organised abroad.

The meeting concluded at 12.30 pm with a vote of thanks.
