Vimala College, Thrissur is a first grade residential women's college affiliated to the University of Calicut. The college is a Christian minority institution run by sisters of C.M.C. (Congregation of Mother of Carmel) Management of the Nirmala Province, Thrissur. Though the college was primarily instituted for catering to the educational needs of the Syro Malabar Catholic community, it is open to all without any distinction of caste or creed.

The college is situated in Vilvattom village, Thrissur Corporation and is under the Thrissur zonal Dy. Director of Collegiate Education, for matters of payment of bills. Bifurcated in 1967 from St. Mary's College, Thrissur, as a degree college, Vimala offers 16 Graduate and 13 Post Graduate Programmes. The college has research centres for English, Commerce and Physics. Vimala college was nationally reaccredited in 2014 by NACC (3rd cycle) at A Grade with CGPA of 3.5 on a 4 point scale. The UGC, Kerala State Government and University of Calicut granted the AUTONOMOUS status to Vimala College in October 2015. This privilege of autonomy is initially for a period of 6 years commencing from the academic year 2016 -17. The college conducts admission and examinations strictly according to the college academic calendar. The students are awarded degrees by the Calicut University for the examinations conducted by the college. In April 2016, the UGC conferred the prestigious 'COLLEGE WITH POTENTIAL FOR EXCELLENCE (CPE)' status to the College.

RULES OF ADMISSION

The admission to all programmes from the academic year 2016-17 is in the autonomous mode. However, the college follows the rules and regulations stipulated by the University of Calicut for the admissions to its UG and PG programmes. It adheres to the eligibility criteria for admission as announced by the University from time to time.

Online admission

The admission procedure begins soon after the publication of the results of the qualifying examinations. The applicants are bound to check the college website for details on admission procedure. The application forms for the UG and PG programmes can be downloaded from the College Website and can be submitted online. The Catholic students (Syro Malabar) should produce a character certificate from the Vicar of their parish in the prescribed online form for the community merit.

Unless otherwise demanded, original certificates need not to be sent along with application (the college authorities will not be responsible for the loss of certificates in such cases), but attested true copies of all relevant certificates and mark lists should be enclosed. The selection list will be published in the college website.

All selections are but provisional and will only be confirmed after the personal interview with the Principal, scrutiny of the certificates, and payment of the fees. If the candidate fails to appear for the interview at the time fixed for her, her seat stands cancelled.

At the interview with the Principal, the applicant should produce the originals of the following:

- 1) Admit Card.
- 2) Transfer Certificate from the School/College last attended.
- 3) Course and Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution.
- 4) Original Mark list.
- 5) Migration Certificate (in the case of applicants coming from other Board / Universities).

- 6) Equivalency Certificate (in the case of applicants coming from other Universities).
- 7) Passport size photos – 4 copies.
- 8) Attested true copies of certificates (10 Nos)
- 9) Other certificates in original.
- 10) CSS Certificate for PG.
- 11) Income Certificate of Parents - original and one attested copy.
- 12) NCC Certificate : Signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC
- 13) NSS Certificate : Signed by the respective authority
- 14) Certificates concerning widows and children of Jawans and Ex-service men and Border Security Force personnel killed or disabled in an action.
15. President's badges in Scouts and Guides, outstanding records in sports and games at the district, state or university levels.

If after the interview, admission is granted, the applicant may get herself enrolled forth-with on payment of fees.

- * The selected candidates and their parents are required to read the Prospectus carefully and sign a declaration of compliance with the rules and code of conduct stipulated by the college before the payment of fees.
- * Fees once paid will not be refunded. Any candidate admitted to Self financing Courses is required to pay the fees for all the three years (UG) / two years (PG) even if she discontinues the course.
- * Original Certificates submitted at the time of admission will not be returned to students during their course of study. Students are therefore directed to keep at least 10 attested true copies of the same before submitting the originals for admission. The Pass Certificates will be returned to them at the end of the course.
- * Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other eligible communities have to produce the Community and Conversion Certificates from the authorities concerned, at the time of admission to get the fee concession and other financial aids from the Government.
- * Other Backward and Forward Community students should also produce Community and Income Certificates to get the benefit of fee concession. They should submit the required certificates and

fill in the necessary application forms for this purpose as and when demanded by the office, failing which the concession cannot be availed.

ASSESSMENT RULES

Assessment is based on the performance of the students throughout the various semesters of the course. Method of Direct Grading is followed for PG Programmes and Indirect Grading is followed for UG Programmes. For both programmes, the evaluation scheme consists of two parts: 20% marks shall be given to the internal assessment and remaining 80% marks shall be for the external evaluation. Components of internal assessment are attendance (25%), assignment / seminar / viva (25%) and test papers (50%).

THE COLLEGE FEES

- (a) Tuition fees and special fees will be collected at the beginning of the academic year.
- (b) The tuition fee will be collected according to the orders given by the Government. Payment of fees should be made even when the student is absent from the college with or without leave.
- (c) Any student who fails to pay the fees or special fees on the due date (i.e. the 7th working day of the academic year) shall be liable to pay a fine of Rs 5/- along with the fees on or before the 10th day after the due date. If the 10th day happens to be a holiday the next working day will be counted as the 10th day.
- (d) If the fees with the fine of Rs 5/- is not paid on or before the 10th day after the due date, an additional fine of Rs10/- will have to be paid. If the fee and fine are not paid within 15 days from this date, the name of the student will be removed from the rolls of the college and entered in a special register of fee defaulters. If she is to be re-admitted, she should seek the special permission of the principal and remit a re-admission fee of Rs 50/- in addition to the arrears of fee with fine. However, the student cannot claim attendance from the day of fee default to the day of re admission.
- (e) All the fee arrears should be settled for claiming attendance to appear for the university examination.

Fee Concession:

- ◆ All the Scheduled Caste, OEC & Scheduled Tribe students are eligible for full fee concession on the submission of their original community certificate at the time of admission. They are also given a lump sum grant / mess fee and pocket money or stipend by the Welfare Department.
- ◆ Those OBC/KPCR & SEBC/FC students whose annual family income is below Rs. 1,00,000/- (Degree) and Rs. 1,00,000/- (P. G.) can avail fee concession from the District Development Office of Scheduled Caste, Thrissur. The students belonging to these communities have to produce duly filled in concession forms, Community Certificates and Income Certificates at the time of admission and submit renewal application forms annually.
- ◆ Full fee concession is also granted to such backward communities from time to time as and when notified by the Department of Harijan Welfare. They have to produce Community and Income Certificates for fee concession.
- ◆ Children of Government servants who died in harness on or after 1st Nov. 1956 are entitled to fee concession at government rates.
- ◆ Students should hold a single bank account of their own and produce this account number along with their Aadhar card number or Aadhar enrolment number for all types of fee concession and scholarships.

Scholarships

Merit Scholarships are generally awarded on the basis of the grades obtained in the qualifying examination.

The students are further directed to visit the website www.scholarships.gov.in www.collegiateedu.kerala.gov.in for further details on scholarships.
2. No student will be awarded more than one scholarship except in the case of SC/ST students.

Vimala Code of Conduct

Education, in its true sense, comprises, besides the acquisition of knowledge, the formation of an ideal character by disciplining of body, mind and soul and by developing everything that is good and beautiful in human nature. Hence every student should aim at cultivating high and noble ideals of life and conduct. She should be gentle and refined in behaviour, polite and courteous in manners and neat and modest in dress and conduct.

1. Rules of modesty, cleanliness and decorum should be strictly adhered to. Modestly stitched plain *Salwar Kameez without slit and plain shawl of any shade without border or design or print is the college uniform. Harem pants, Churi bottoms, patialas, leggings and short tops are not allowed.* The college special uniform is to be worn on all first Mondays and on special occasions. The special uniform for students of each batch should be worn on all other Mondays. No gold or gold coloured imitation or any other ornaments except earrings can be worn. However, the married students can wear a small chain and the wedding ring.

2. The college property and furniture should be handled with great care. Any loss or destruction of these will be chargeable individually or collectively as the case may be.
3. Students shall endeavour to preserve cleanliness and order in classrooms, verandahs and college premises. Dislocating chairs and other furniture, dirtying the surroundings by throwing bits of paper and sprinkling ink on the floor, wall and furniture, writing on walls, benches, desks and trees are not in keeping with the high sense of order and cleanliness expected of a lady.
4. Books, stationery and umbrellas should bear the name of the owner. The college will not be responsible for the loss of money or any article from students. They are likewise forbidden to borrow or lend money or other articles.
5. Electronic devices other than for the purpose of study should not be brought to the college or hostels without the permission of the Principal.
6. Strict silence should be observed at all times during class hours in the class rooms and in the verandahs.
7. No student should be seen wandering outside during class hours.
8. Irregular attendance, insubordination to lecturers, habitual inattention to class work and obscenity in word or deed are sufficient reasons for the permanent or temporary dismissal of a student.
9. No Magazine/Newspaper/subscription of any kind is allowed in the campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
10. Fund collection of any kind by the students without the prior permission of principal is strictly forbidden.
11. Official letters addressed to the college authorities expecting replies should enclose self - addressed stamped envelope.
12. Those students who require any certificates for any purpose should make a request to the college office for the same at least one week ahead of their requirement.

13. No notice should be pasted on the notice board without the permission of the Principal.
14. Important notices will be displayed on the students' notice board. The students should read the notices on the notice board daily.
15. Plagiarism or other forms of academic dishonesty, furnishing false information to any college official, faculty member or office, forgery, alteration, or misuse of any college document, record, or instrument of identification, copying in examination etc. will subject the student to strict disciplinary actions including suspension and dismissal.
16. Students should make use of library during free hours. If the teacher in charge does not arrive in the respective class on time (without any prior information) the class representative should inform the principal after 15 minutes.
17. Canteen facility is intended only for Vimala family members.
18. Non-hostellers are not supposed to enter hostel premises without the prior permission of the principal and the hostel warden.
19. Wearing college identity card is mandatory for all our students for entering college premises and for all dealings in the college. Duplicate identity card will be issued only in unavoidable circumstances with the declaration of student and parents/guardian with a fine of Rs.100/-
20. The use of mobile phones by students in the campus is strictly prohibited and violation of this rule will subject the student to severe disciplinary actions.
21. Political activities are banned in the campus by rule (Vide : W.A.No.535 of 2003-Judgement dt 26-05-2003) of the honourable high court of Kerala. Student should not resort to Gheraos, Bandh, Harthal and any sort of violence with the campus.
22. Students are warned against presenting mass petitions to the principal or to the manager. They should not participate in
 - (a) Any agitation directed against constituted authority

- (b) Any meeting likely to excite disloyalty towards the Government
 - (c) Any meeting likely to promote communal ill-feeling.
23. All catholic students should attend the annual retreat without fail.
 24. Ragging is prohibited by law in the college campus.
 25. Students can convene meeting only with the prior permission of the Principal. Persons who are not on the roles of the college register will not be allowed to take part in any propaganda work in the college campus. Students from other institution and outsiders with valid identity proof should take prior permission to meet the Principal. Even staff members cannot convene a meeting of the students inside the campus without the prior written consent of the Principal.
 26. The Principal has the complete authority to amend or modify any rule or regulation.

Attendance and Leave

1. The working day is divided into two sessions and each session into different periods.
2. At the first bell for the morning session all students should be in their respective classes for the morning prayer.
3. The first bell for class is given 5 minutes before the commencement of the morning and afternoon sessions and the second bell at the time fixed for the commencement of class.
4. Late comers could enter the class only with the permission of the lecturer-in-charge.
5. There will be a very short break of 5 minutes after the 2nd hour of the morning session.
6. Attendance will be taken every hour.
7. No student is allowed to leave the class room without the permission of the lecturer-in-charge.
8. No student is permitted to leave the college before the class is over. In cases of genuine necessity, the student should get the

permission of the tutor and the Principal before leaving the campus. The parents are advised to inform the class tutor and the Principal in such necessities.

9. Leave or absence must be recorded in the leave book of each class maintained by the respective tutors. Parents are advised to inform the tutors in advance of their ward's absence. The students can avail the leave forms from the college office on payment of Rs. 2/-. Application for leave must be recommended by the tutor-in-charge and forwarded to the Principal.
10. In case of illness, a medical certificate should be produced.
11. Unauthorised absence will be dealt with by the Principal.
12. Attendance, as stipulated by the University, is mandatory for all students, to appear for the end semester examination. A minimum of 75% attendance for each course or paper is necessary for all students. In case of an attendance shortage, the student's chance to appear for the end semester examination stands cancelled and she can only reappear for the exam the following year.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

1. Ethics and Value Education

Keeping with the mission and vision of the institution as laid down by the founders, ethical values that underlie the very fiber of education and dissemination of knowledge, is institutionalized and integrated into the system. Activities are designed so as to cater generally and individually to the Catholic and Non-Catholic students. All faculty members are actively involved in handling ethics and catechism classes. One hour on every week is attributed for ethics/catechism classes. Common programmes has also been conducted like retreats, talks by external experts, camps etc. has been conducted periodically to cater this particular aspect.

2. Mentoring System

The College has a mentoring or tutorial system. 25-30 students are placed under the guidance of one teacher and he/she supervises

the academic progress of his / her students and also gives them educational cum personal guidance. The third hour of every Friday is assigned as the tutorial hour.

3. Scholar Support Programme (SSP)

The college implements Scholar Support Programme as part of the “New Initiatives in Higher Education” initiated by the Dept of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala. SSP aims at imparting additional support to students in curricular areas. Special classes and learning materials are also provided to the students.

4. Walk With Scholar Programme (WWS)

The college implements Walk With Scholar Programme as part of the “New Initiatives in Higher Education” initiated by the Dept of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala. This scheme built on the concept of mentor as ‘guide’ and ‘friend’ provides specialised mentoring programme for undergraduate students in Arts, Science and Commerce. WWS gives necessary guidance, motivation and mental support to students in identifying appropriate areas for higher studies as well as for employment.

5. Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP)

Vimala college is a Partner Institute with ASAP Mission, Govt. of Kerala in training graduate and postgraduate students for empanelling them as Skill Development Executives (SDE). As a Trainer Partner Institution, the college provides 21 day residential training to the student trainees on behalf of ASAP Mission. Besides, the college also offers regular ASAP training classes to I semester UG students.

6. Jesus Youth

‘Jesus Youth’ is an international catholic youth movement active in different countries throughout the world. This charismatic missionary movement blending spirituality with social service and teaching how to celebrate the ‘life with God’ has made its vibrant presence felt in our campus for the last two decades.

7. All India Catholic University Federation (AICUF)

The AICUF unit functioning in Vimala College provides platform for students to develop their spirituality and leadership quality. It is helpful in cultivating responsibility, faith, social commitment and patriotic zeal in students.

8. Centre for Women's Studies (CWS)

The Centre for Women's Studies sponsored by the UGC has been operational in Vimala College since 8 March 2010. Vimala College is the only college in the entire state of Kerala that has got such a centre. The centre organises various gender sensitisation programmes and awareness classes for women in the college and in the community.

9. Career Oriented Add-on & Certificate Courses

The Add-on and Certificate Courses are conducted regularly on all Mondays and Tuesdays. The completion of any one of these courses in the first year of UG Programme is a requisite for all students as per college norms. The Add-on Courses aim at developing the professional skill of the students and also at developing their personality. Foreign language courses in French and German offered by the college will be an added advantage to the students seeking employment abroad.

10. Women Development Cell (WDC)

This is an initiative of Kerala Government for empowering women. Its motto is 'Empowered Women: Nation's Strength'.

The cell has rendered immense contribution to the students and the local community in giving awareness, guidance, counselling, training and welfare programmes for women.

9. Career Guidance and Placement Cell

The Career Guidance cell imparts training in various soft skills needed to get placement. Regular classes are conducted on topics like personality development, effective communication, higher

education and job opportunities. The career guidance classes will be usually conducted on Thursdays. By maintaining wide contacts with various recruiting agencies, this cell keeps the students informed of the opportunities arising in different companies. Many students have secured placement in various banks and industries through campus recruitment.

10. Vimala College Union

The College Union is constituted with the following objectives:

- a) To train the students of the college in the parliamentary democracy so that they may be responsible citizens of India, aware of their duties, responsibilities and rights.
- b) To uphold, implement and work for the ideals of the College in a befitting manner by organising programmes with the prior sanction of the Principal.
- c) To foster and promote good and cordial relations between the students and the staff members.
- d) To promote healthy and responsible participation in fine arts and other extra curricular activities.

The election to the college union is conducted on the parliamentary model as per para 6.2.4 of the J.M. Lyngdoh Commission Report and order passed by the Supreme Court of India in SLP No. 24295/2004. The college union will have a students' general council and an executive Committee. All students are members of the students' general council. In order to conduct election to the executive council, an electoral council consisting of two elected representatives from each class will be formed. The electoral council will elect the executive committee consisting of the following office bearers: the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, General Secretary, University Union Councillors Magazine Editor and the Arts Club Secretary. There shall be a Secretary of Sports who will be nominated by the committee consisting of the Principal, the Head of the Dept. of Physical Education and the Dean of students' Welfare. One member representing the students

of each year of the U.G. and P.G. course elected by and from among the student representatives of the respective years in the electoral council will also represent in the executive council.

Language secretaries of Malayalam, English and Hindi and they will function as assistant editors for the respective sections of the college magazine. The candidates contesting to the electoral council should possess minimum of 80% attendance in the previous year (except in the case of first year students) and should have passed all the examinations held till then. Those who were granted condonation of attendance in the previous year are not eligible to contest in the election. Similarly, anyone against whom disciplinary action of any kind has been taken inside or outside the campus, ipso facto stands debarred from contesting in the elections to the electoral council.

Students are forbidden to contest in the Union election on the label of student organization. The decisions are made in the college council.

The Principal is the Ex-officio Treasurer and patron of the College Union.

11. Counselling Service

The counselling service provided in the college is aimed at enabling the students to overcome inhibitions. One to one, free, confidential counselling service is made available to all students to help them deal with academic, personal, emotional, family or social problems.

12. Grievance Redressal Cell

There are separate Grievance Redressal Cells for the staff and students. Grievances regarding administration, teaching, learning, university results, conduct of examinations, valuation, and so forth are dealt with by this cell.

13. Anti-Ragging Cell

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the campus by law. The anti-ragging cell constituted in the college handles any issues of harassment

- mental, physical or sexual - and strict action will be taken against the violators.

14. Mobile Phone Search Squad

A mobile phone search squad to monitor the use and misuse of mobile phones in the campus by students is constituted in the college as per the directions from the government. The mobile phone search squad of the institution holds the right to conduct raids and confiscate the mobile phones and take strict disciplinary action against those who bring mobile phones to the campus. Mobile phones, camera and other electronic gadgets for entertainment are prohibited in campus.

15. Feedback mechanism

The college has institutionalised a very effective mechanism to elicit feedback from the students. Every academic year each student gets the opportunity to evaluate the teaching learning process, curriculum, administration of principal, student support activities and infrastructure. A 'Talk to Principal' box is placed in the college for the students to communicate their thoughts directly to the principal. Students can directly interact with the Principal every month.

16. Research and Consultancy Service

The research committee not only monitors the research activities in the college but also strives to create a research culture on campus. Consultancy service has also been initiated on the campus.

17. PTA

The PTA is an integral part of college activities. It has also been instrumental in mobilising the resources for the welfare activities of the college.

18. Alumnae Association

This constitutes the growing body of former students and retired staff of the institution. Besides occasional informal meetings, the Alumnae organizes a general body meeting every year on the second Saturday of October. The Association also conducts various activities

in the college, notably the Star of Vimala Contest for the outgoing students. The life members of Alumnae Association can access the college library for 5 years.

19. Sports

Vimala has a place of pride in the map of sports and games. Over and above the strong Athletics group, we have teams of Hand Ball, Judo, Weight Lifting, Swimming, Tennis and Power Lifting. We have sports hostel in Athletics, Swimming, Judo, Power lifting and Weightlifting. Several of our sports stars have attained national and international acclaim through intensive training and coaching given in the college.

20. NSS

Two NSS units consisting of 200 students function in the College. The aim of these units is to promote among the students a spirit of service to the fellowmen. Social Service, free tuition to the poor school children and rural upliftment are some of the important programmes of the scheme.

21. NCC

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) Unit functioning in the College aims at developing qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, the spirit of adventure, sportsmanship and the ideals of selfless service. The cadets also ensure a general discipline in the campus on normal days and on special occasions.**22**

22. Clubs, Forums and Associations

Departmental associations and various inter departmental clubs and forums function in the college. The clubs and forums with teacher coordinators provide a venue for the students to display their various talents and also help in fostering friendship among students.

23. Library

Vimala maintains an excellent library. The main aim of the library is to support and enrich the curriculum in all subject areas. The library

expands its collection and functions along with the growth of the college and caters to the needs of all the departments. The library has INFLIBNET facility and can be accessed at www.vimalalibrary.libsoft.org. Library follows Open Access System, which is fully automated with LIBSOFT package. It is the first library under Calicut University to manage its catalogue and circulation with barcodes. The library and the reading room remain open on all working days and Saturdays.

Library Working Hours :

Working Days - 8 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.

Saturdays - 8.30 a.m. to 3.30 p.m.

An active Library Club comprising of students from different batches functions in the college. The library committee will take the decisions for the library.

Library Rules

- 1) Students shall bring their identity cards and library cards, and record their entrance by swiping.
- 2) Students are not allowed to lend their library cards to others.
- 3) Personal belongings are to be placed at the property counter.
- 4) Perfect silence must be observed in the library, reading room and its immediate premises. Users are not allowed to sit on the steps or stand near the door.
- 5) Combined reference work or discussion can be done only in the permitted area.
- 6) 3 books will be issued to the UG students and 8 books to the PG students at a time.
- 7) Students are not allowed to exchange library books or lend them to anybody. They are strictly forbidden to borrow books on behalf of other students.
- 8) Books are to be handled with care. Damage or loss of books should be immediately reported to the librarian. Avoid tearing

the pages of books or scribbling on them. This is a punishable offence.

- 9) Books issued may be retained only for 14 days. Fine will be charged for delay in returning (Fine - Re. 1 per book per day).
- 10) Books in the Reference Section will not be issued and should be consulted within the library.
- 11) Periodicals are to be replaced in their respective places.
- 12) Library cards are to be returned on the completion of the course or on discontinuation of the course.
- 13) All library arrears should be cleared by the student borrowers before they receive their Hall Tickets for University Examinations or before obtaining the TC, if they leave before the completion of the course.
- 14) Prior written permission of principal is needed for non-Vimalities to use library facility and they have to take library membership with a payment of fees (Reference works will not be issued)
- 15) Internet facility for academic purpose is made available for the students. Browsing social medias and non-academic sites are prohibited.

SERVICE AND EXTENSION ACTIVITIES OF VIMALA COLLEGE

1. VCASS

Vimala Community Aid Sponsorship Scheme is a sponsorship programme of Vimala College. One hundred academically bright but socially and economically backward school children from the neighbouring schools are identified and their school education is sponsored by the college.

2. CHILDLINE (Contact No. 1098)

The aim of CHILDLINE is to protect the rights of children and to ensure access to quality services to the poorest of poor. It is a network that has evolved through a partnership between the Ministry of Woman and Child Development, Govt. of India and the UNICEF. Vimala College is the Nodal organisation of CHILDLINE, Thrissur.

3. Family Counselling Centre (FCC)

This is sponsored by the Central Social Welfare Board, Government of India. It provides counselling service to students and extends its service to Women's Cell, family court and schools in the locality. They also organise premarital counselling seminars.

4. Vimala Community Extension Centre (VCEC)

Vimala Community Extension Centre is a social work institution of the college. It conducts classes in tailoring. The FCC & CHILDLINE function under VCEC.

5. Sasneham

It is a charity venture initiated by the staff and students of Vimala College.

6. The Golden Jubilee charity projects - 'Kanivu' & 'Unarvu'

The '*Kanivu*' project offers scholarships to the financially weaker students of the college whose parents are critically / terminally ill.

The '*Unarvu*' project of the college gives bicycles to the financially backward students coming from remote and far off areas to the college.
