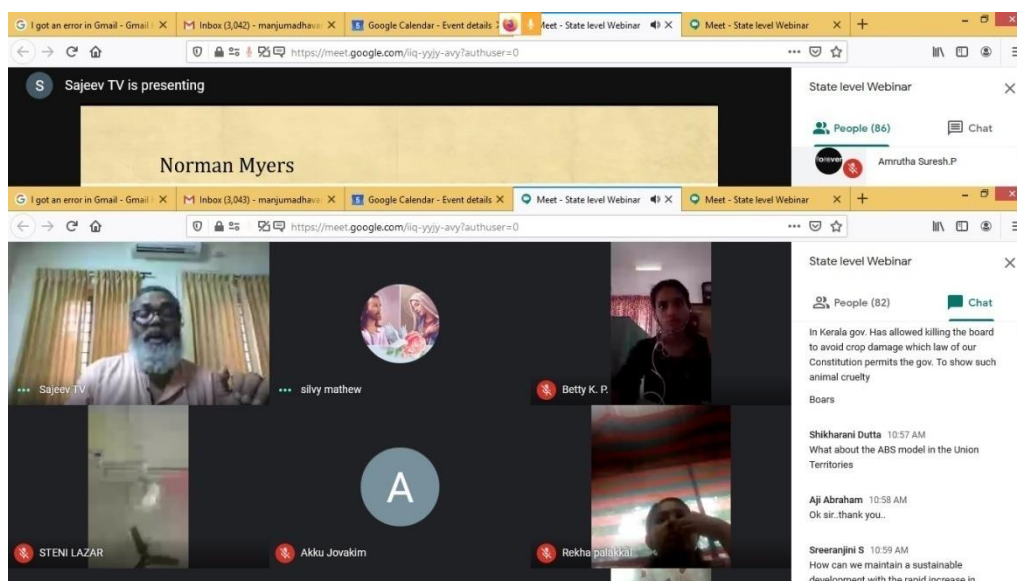


## DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY
