TEAM COMPOSITION

- Each team must have a minimum of 6 members and a maximum of 10 members.
- Members may represent different characters from a single fictional world or a mix under a unifying theme. (Ex: villains, princesses)
- Multiple entries from the same college are allowed.
- Each team must appoint one representative for coordination and registration.

PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

- Each team will get up to 7 minutes for their performance.
- Each team must begin with a brief introduction (1 minute) describing their chosen theme or concept. The introduction may be delivered live or as a recorded narration.
- Dialogue or monologues, short performances etc may be included but is optional.
- Teams may use background music, sound effects, or voiceovers.
- The music should be submitted beforehand to the event coordinator.
- Props are allowed but no hazardous materials are permitted on stage
- Costumes must be decent, relevant, and reflect creativity and effort.
- Teams are responsible for their own costumes, makeup, and props.



Reporting Time : 10:00 am

- **Individual participation only.**
- **Each participant will be assigned a character they are already familiar with.**
- **The character will be given 2 days in advance via email along with detailed instructions .**
- **Competition will be held in 2 rounds - introduction and Q&A session.**
- **Participants will be judged on depth of character understanding, performance consistency and clarity in Q&A.**
