Scope

The district-level flash mob event aims to create an energetic and inclusive platform for the youth to express their talents and enthusiasm through creative performances. Organized under the leadership of the state government and the Department of Youth Affairs, this initiative seeks to bring together young people from different communities to promote unity, cultural exchange, and youth empowerment.

The programme serves as a medium to showcase artistic and cultural expressions in public spaces, encouraging youth participation in community-oriented activities. It also highlights the role of youth in spreading positive messages, building social harmony, and strengthening their engagement with developmental initiatives.

Objective

- 1. Raise awareness about the harmful effects of drug and substance abuse among students and the general public.
- 2. Use creative expression (dance/performance) to deliver an impactful social message.
- 3. Engage youth actively in the anti-drug campaign through participatory methods.
- 4. Capture public attention in a non-traditional, high-impact format that encourages discussion and reflection.
- 5. Educate viewers on the psychological, social, and legal consequences of drug use
- 6. Increase awareness of support services, such as the Vimukthi Helpline (14405), for counselling and rehabilitation.

Outcomes of the Programme

- 1. Increased awareness among students and the public about the dangers of drug abuse and substance addiction.
- 2. Improved public engagement through the use of creative, youth-led performances that made the anti-drug message more relatable and memorable.
- 3. Enhanced student participation in social initiatives, empowering them to take leadership roles in drug prevention campaigns.
- 4. Strengthened campus commitment to building a drug-free environment by encouraging the formation of Vimukthi clubs and peer support networks.
- 5. Wider dissemination of information about the Vimukthi campaign and available support systems, including the helpline (14405).

Department of Sociology in association with the Kerala State Excise Department and Vimukthi Mission – Thrissur Division, as part of their ongoing efforts to combat drug abuse among youth organised a flash mob competition. . It was held on October 7, 2025, at Vimala College, Thrissur, Kerala. The program aimed to raise awareness about the dangers of substance abuse, particularly among college students, and to promote the broader vision of creating a drug-free academic environment through creative and community-driven initiatives. The Department of Sociology Coordinated the activities.

Substance abuse among youth, particularly in educational institutions, has emerged as a serious social challenge in Kerala. Recognizing the urgency to combat this issue, the Kerala State Excise Department, through the Vimukthi Mission, is implementing a multi-pronged awareness and intervention strategy. As part of this campaign, a district-level flash mob awareness programme is being organized to spread awareness among college students and the general public. Flash mobs are being employed as a creative and impactful means of communication to engage youth and provoke thought about the adverse consequences of drug abuse.


