6. Any other matter

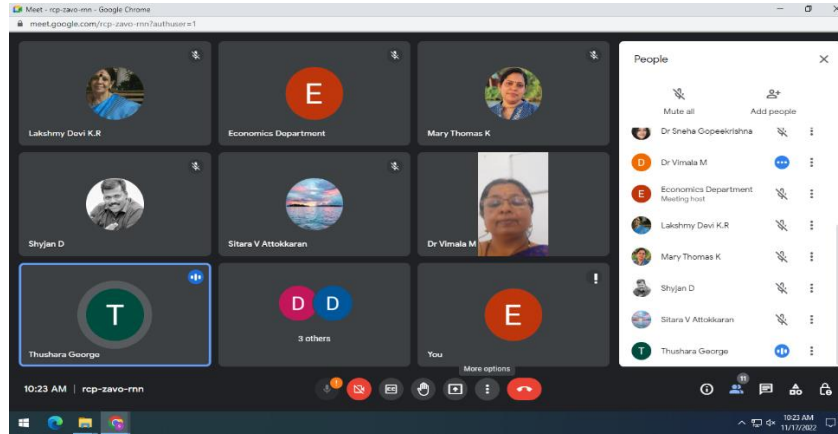
It was followed by the discussion on the agenda.

- Dr. Thushara George suggested to give more prominence to curriculum-based activities related to the discipline and it was resolved to conduct activities such as an Economics Fest including variety competitions based on the Curriculum.

- Dr. Shyjan Dlenthi's support and expertise in conducting the following activities:

(1) provide regular sessions of one or two weeks by bringing Visiting Professors outside the state to interact with the students.

(2) A program with the finance minister to highlight the importance given to the higher education and research in the Budget and to discuss how research findings have to be translated to policies

(3) Legislative Assembly visit for students

(4) Interaction sessions with State Finance Administrative staff.

- Adding to this, Dr. Soni T L offered her support towards department activities as a collaboration with JNU and also to collaborate with the Projects undertaken by the District Planning office
- As per these suggestions, it was resolved to conduct more activities based on the curriculum.
- As per the letter No. 4933/GA - IV - B - SO/2012/CU (I) dated 04/04/2022 received from the University of Calicut regarding the approval of the Syllabus of MA Economics Programme (2021 onwards), it was decided to resubmit the syllabus by including the Programme Specific Outcomes and Course Outcomes.
