### **Objectives**

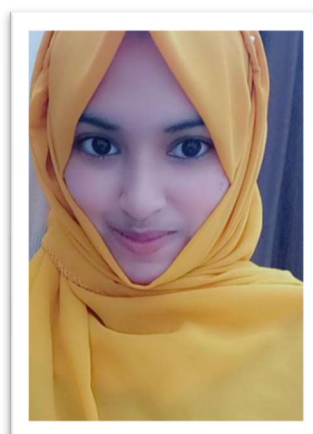
1. To familiarize students, researchers and faculty with various steps to be taken in their pursuits of securing their inventions and innovations
