





On 18/07/2019 the programme Pararaksha, meaning save the life of a person on his emergency situation, was inaugurated by Sree K P Joy, Secretary (sub judge) District legal services authority, Thrissur. Dr.C K Brahmaputhran, Medical superintendent, Daya hospital Thrissur, has given a talk on the importance of practicing first AIDs. A one dayworkshop based on emergency life saving measures was conducted at Vimala College by the faculty of Daya Hospital, Thrissur.It was a very informative session which opened our eyes to minute techniques, which if given at the right time can work wonders. In this session, we were introduced to CPR or Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation.CPR is an emergency procedure that combines chest compressions often with artificial ventilation in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function untill, further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person who is in cardiac arrest. It is recommended in those who are unresponsive with no breathing or abnormal breathing, for example, agonalrespirations. The rescuer may also provide artificial ventilation by either exhaling air into the subject's mouth or nose (mouth to mouth resuscitation) or using a device that pushes air into the subject's lungs (mechanical ventilation). We were also informed about a technique known as Heimlich maneuver which helps in solving problems concerned with choking on food particles. If an adult is choking and cannot breathe, the Heimlich maneuver can dislodge the foreign body responsible for the victim choking. According to this technique: from behind, wrap your arms around the back of the victim and form a fist below the victim's ribcage but above his belly button. Grasp your fist with the other hand and press into the victim's upper



abdomen with a quick upper thrust and continue until the foreign object is expelled. These simple measures are very much informative and we the NSS volunteers are truly grateful to have received such an educational seminar which equipped us with first aid techniques for crisis management in the medical field.
