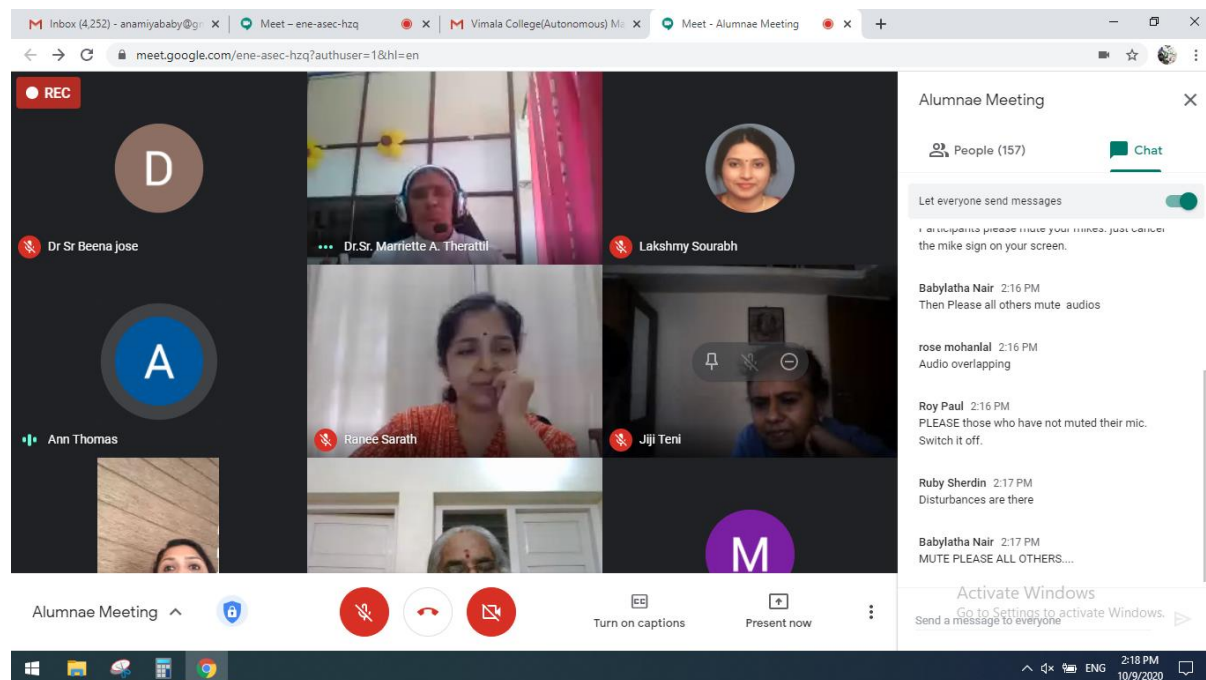
Thereafter, General Body meeting was held and it was decided to retain the same office bearers for the next year 2020-21
