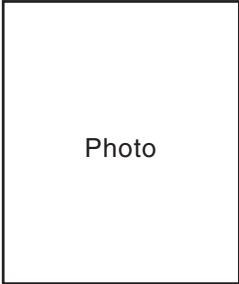

 8. Attested true copies of certificates (10 Nos)
 9. Other certificates in original
 10. Income Certificate of Parents - original and one attested copy
 11. NCC Certificate : Signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC
 12. NSS Certificate : Signed by the respective authority
 13. Certificates concerning widows and children of Jawans and Ex-service men and Border Security Force personnel killed or disabled in an action
 14. President's badges in Scouts and Guides, outstanding records in sports and games at the district, state or university levels
 15. Catholic students (Syro Malabar) to be considered for community merit are to produce a character certificate from the Vicar of their parish in the prescribed online form
- ◆ Fees once paid will not be refunded.

- ◆ Original Certificates submitted at the time of admission will be returned only after completion of the course of study. Students are, therefore, directed to maintain at least 10 attested copies of the same before submitting the originals for admission procedure
- ◆ Request for the original certificate from the college should be made at least one week prior to the requirement
- ◆ Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other eligible communities should produce the Community and Conversion Certificates from the authorities concerned, at the time of admission, to avail fee concession and other financial aids from the Government
- ◆ Other Backward and Forward Community students should also produce Community and Income Certificates to avail fee concession
- ◆ Prospective candidates and their parents should read the Prospectus carefully and sign a declaration of compliance with the rules and code of conduct stipulated by the College before the payment of fees
- ◆ Unless otherwise demanded, original certificates need not be sent along with the application and the college cannot be held responsible for the loss of any documents. Attested copies of all relevant certificates and mark lists should be enclosed.

SCHEDULE FOR FEE REMITTANCE

1. Tuition fee is determined according to the orders issued by the Government
2. Tuition fees and special fees will be collected at the beginning of the academic year:

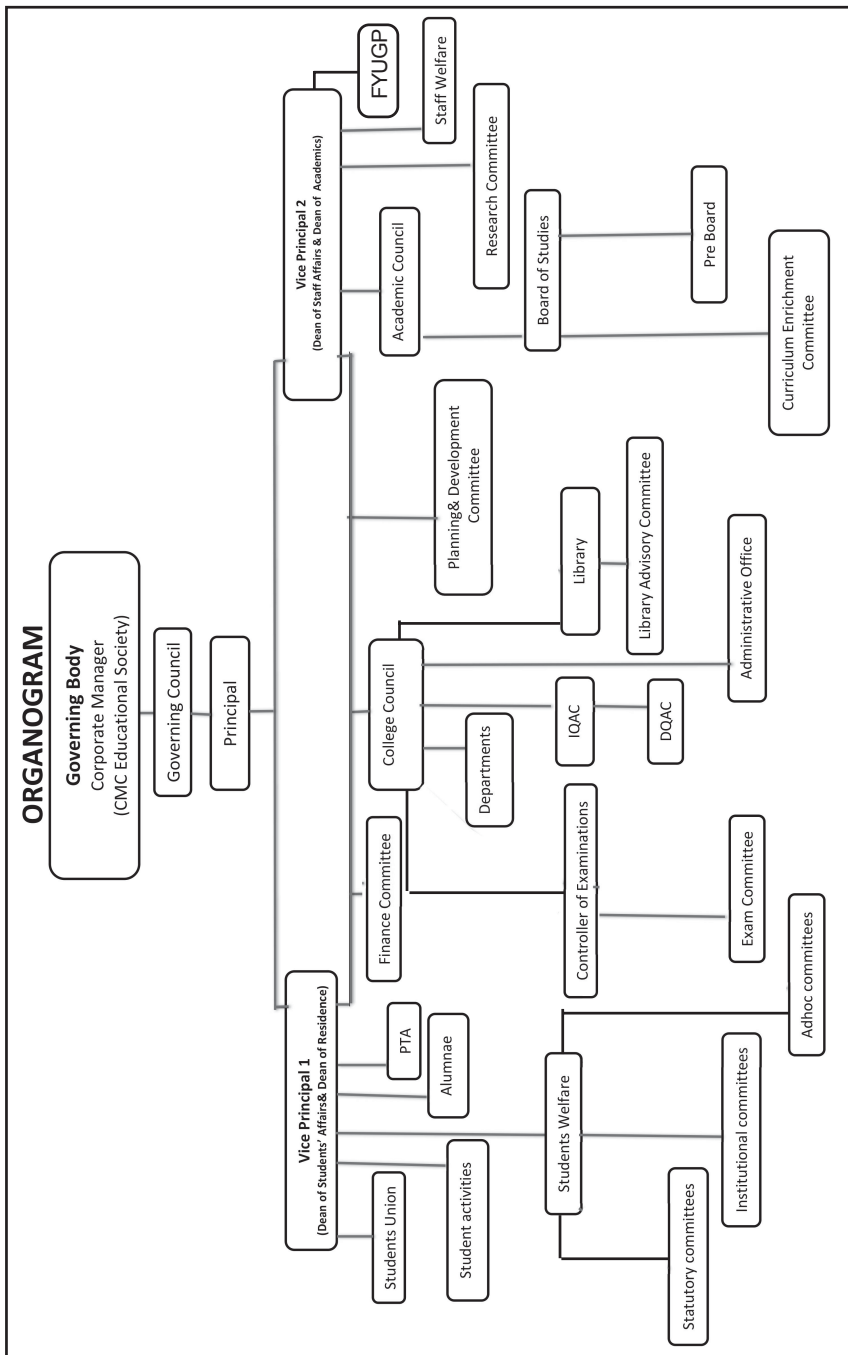

VIMALA CODE OF CONDUCT

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

PREAMBLE

This document indicates the standard procedures and practices of Vimala College for all the students enrolled with the College for pursuing various programmes and courses. All students of the College are expected to be well conversant with this Code and abide by this code of conduct.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. It is mandatory to wear the college identity card in campus and also while commuting to College.
2. Ragging is prohibited by law in the college campus.
3. Political activities are banned in the campus by rule (Vide: W.A.No. 535 of 2003 - Judgement dt 26-05-2003) of the honourable High Court of Kerala. Students should not resort to Gheraos, Bandh, Harthal or any sort of violence within the campus.
4. Students must adhere to the dress code of the institution.
5. No gold or gold coloured imitation ornaments is permitted. Fine will be levied for wearing gold ornaments.
6. The College is committed to educationally sound use of technology. Any use of technology that degrades the learning environment, promotes dishonesty or is used for illegal activities may be prohibited.
7. The use of mobile phones in the campus is in accordance with the Government rules and regulations. Mobile phones should not be used during the class hours. Electronic devices other than for the purpose of study should not be brought to the College or hostel without the permission of the Principal.
8. No magazine or newspaper subscription of any kind is allowed in the campus without the prior permission of the Principal
9. Students are warned against representing any mass petitions to the Principal or to the Manager. They should not participate in any agitation directed against the constituted authority or any meeting likely to excite disloyalty towards the Government or any meeting likely to promote communal ill-feeling or any activity that will cause unrest on campus.

10. Students can convene meetings only with the prior permission of the Principal.
11. Persons who are not on the rolls of the college register are not allowed inside the college campus.
12. Plagiarism or other forms of academic dishonesty, furnishing false information to any college official, faculty or office, forgery, alteration or misuse of any college document, record, or instrument of identification, copying in examination etc. will call for strict disciplinary action amounting to suspension, dismissal and debarring from examinations.
13. Irregular attendance, insubordination to lecturers, habitual inattention in class, obscenity in word or deed are sufficient reasons for permanent or temporary dismissal of a student.
14. Fund collection of any kind by students without the prior knowledge or permission of the Principal is strictly forbidden.
15. Official letters addressed to the college authorities expecting response should include self- addressed stamped envelope.
16. Important information will be disseminated through notice boards, announcements over common announcement system, website, department mails, class whatsapp groups, class tutors and class representatives, depending on the nature of the information.
17. Displaying notices without permission of the Principal is forbidden.
18. Non-hostellers are not allowed to enter hostel premises without prior permission of the Dean of Residence.
19. College property should be handled with care. Loss, damage or destruction will be chargeable individually or collectively as the case may be.
20. Misbehavior in class or campus will be punished. The nature of punishment will depend upon the severity of the offence and will be decided by the Tutor/ Dean of Students/ Principal
21. The Principal has the complete authority to amend or modify any rule or regulation.

Attendance and Absence (UG / PG)

- Attendance will be taken every hour
- Attendance, as stipulated by the University, is mandatory for all students, to appear for the end semester examination

- Minimum attendance required for each course:75%
- Condonation of shortage of attendance: As per University Regulation.
- Participation / attendance certificate in curricular / extra curricular activities attended inside or outside the campus with the prior concurrence of the principal to be produced to claim attendance in college. (Limited to 9 days in a semester).
- A student with less than 50% attendance is not eligible to continue the programme and has to seek readmission.
- Admission to repeat the courses will be within the sanctioned strength.
- Medical certificate issued by a physician not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon in Government service should be produced for claiming medical leave.
- Absence of a student on any day shall be intimated to the Tutor. Absence must be recorded in the leave book maintained by the respective tutors. Leave application (leave forms available in the college office) duly signed by the parents should be submitted to the Tutor.
- No re-examination will be conducted for students who are absent for internal examinations
- Students should remain in college until the classes are dispersed. In exceptional cases, students will be permitted to leave the campus before class dispersal only on written request from parents/guardian.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEACHERS

As per UGC guidelines whoever adopts teaching as a profession assumes the obligation to conduct himself/herself in accordance with the ideals of the profession. The profession requires that the teacher should be calm, patient and communicative by temperament and amiable by disposition. A teacher is constantly under the scrutiny of his/her students and the society at large. Therefore, every teacher should ensure that there is no incompatibility between his/her precepts and practice. The national ideals of education must be considered as his/her own ideals.

The teacher is entrusted with a great social responsibility and the basic ethical values expected of a teacher are care, trust, integrity and respect.

General code of conduct for teaching and non-teaching staff

- All staff members are bound to obey the Education Policy of the CMC Management.
- Every staff member should **uphold professional and social values** and discharge his / her duties diligently to match the standards and performance norms laid down by the college, university and the government from time to time.
- No staff member shall by act or deed degrade, harass or insult any other person for any reason whatsoever or act in a manner unbecoming of the profession.
- No staff member shall act in any manner that violates the norms of decency or morality in his/her conduct or behaviour inside or outside the College Campus.
- Publishing comments on the social media in the name of the college without the prior permission of the Head of the institution is prohibited.
- The staff members should be polite and courteous towards their colleagues, assisting them and sharing the responsibilities in a collaborative manner.
- Every staff member should **update his / her professional competency and skills** and equip himself / herself professionally to discharge the duties assigned to him / her.
- Every staff member should **maintain professional integrity** and shall not indulge in any organized anti-institutional activity and shall not promote, abet, assist or motivate any unhealthy activity against the College Management.
- No staff (teaching and non-teaching) employed in the college shall engage directly or indirectly in any trade or business.
- No members of the staff (teaching and non-teaching) shall engage in any political activity within the college campus.
- Id card is mandatory for all the teaching and non-teaching staff and they should wear it while they are inside the campus.
