CHILDLINE Activity Report (April – March 2020-21)

CHILDLINE 1098 is a phone number that spells hope for millions of children across India. It is a 24-hour a day, 365 days a year, free, emergency phone service for children in need of aid and assistance. We not only respond to the emergency needs of children but also link them to relevant services for their long-term care and rehabilitation. We have, till date, connected to three million children across the nation offering them care and protection.

As on 31st March, 2020, CHILDLINE services are now available to children across 569 cities and districts, covering over 77% of the Indian landscape. This is made possible through a well-integrated network of 1011 partner organisations and 128 Child Help Desks operating at railway stations. CHILDLINE operates centralised call centres from 6 regional locations. CHILDLINE service not only plays the role of listening to the child but also aids in strengthening and moulding the current National Child Protection Mechanisms.

In Kerala CHILDLINE India Foundation works 36 with partners in 14 districts of Kerala State to protect the rights, lives, well-being and future of every child, CHILDLINE India Foundation along with Ministry of Women and Child Development- New Delhi upheld its reputation as a national leader in both humanitarian and development contexts. Through its advocacy plan from 2018 to 2020 continues, Childline's last five years of results achieved for and with children and looks ahead to new challenges on the road to achieving the a child-friendly nation so that every child born has a protected and contented life. This report draws a major strides accomplished by CHILDLINE to ensure and enhance child protection in Kerala.

CHILDLINE in Thrissur

CHILDLINE in Thrissur District started to function in the year 2002. Vimala College, Thrissur functions as the Nodal Organization of CHILDLINE, Vimala College along with the Collaborative agency, St. Christina Holy Angel's Home Pullazhy and Railway Child Help Desk agency, ATMA Foundation has done many activities in the district for children. Providing services to the children in need of care and protection, coordinating with Government Departments, networking with the members of the allied system, organizing various programs, etc were done to prorogate the activities of CHILDLINE. CHILDLINE India Foundation provides the necessary support for the smooth functioning of the various activities. This report covers the activities of CHILDLINE Thrissur during the period of 1st April to September 2020.

Reporting of unclassified cases life referral to other services like, educational materials, other CHILDLINES, Excise, DLSA, FCC etc. are the highest number of cases during this period followed by Emotional support and guidance. 59 Emotional abuse and 58 physical abuse cases were happened during this period. 35 Child Sexual Abuse cases are reported during this period at Thrissur District. We could provide Nutritional support to the children during this pandemic and 49 children were benefitted.







